



WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The percentage of residents in the complete but up to date group has increased by 7.9 percentage points from 2022-11-13 to 2023-02-05 while the LeadingAge member nursing homes have seen an increase of 10.18 percentage points during this same period. The increase in the percentage of up to date residents has slowed greatly in the past few weeks. LeadingAge members this past week have seen and increase higher than the national rate.

ACTIVITIES THIS WEEK

- LeadingAge hosted an informal roundtable with nursing home members who have reached a high percentage of residents receiving the Covid vaccine including the booster. Best practices were shared in the roundtable that focused on education, tracking, personal staff interaction and expert medical led meetings virtual and in-person. Our members expressed the ability to have the vaccine at the ready and cited access as a factor in helping to vaccinate immediately when a resident or even a staff member was informed and ready to receive the vaccine.
- On Thursday, February 16th, LeadingAge released the **Updated Vaccines Grant Funding**, that is now available. [LeadingAge has further expanded our partnership with the Department of Health and Human Services](#) (HHS) and the [We Can Do This](#) campaign to provide LeadingAge members a new grant opportunity for executing vaccine clinics in an effort to boost updated vaccine uptake for staff, residents, family members, and others in the community. Funds are available and HHS is anxious to see vaccine clinics start immediately.

STATE PARTNER HIGHLIGHTS

- LeadingAge state partners are receiving their specific state analysis and are working with members to help increase booster rates and follow-up on best practices of high percentage nursing homes.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- In the next few weeks, we will focus on helping LeadingAge members apply for the grant funds available to help increase vaccine uptake prior to the March 18th closure of the campaign.

LOOKING FORWARD

- LeadingAge will participate in the February 22nd meeting with other associations and ASPR to discuss the ending of the PHE and pharmacy/vaccine concerns.

DATA DICTIONARY

- Total
 - The total residents listed in the data published by CMS from the NHSN from nursing homes who submitted data and the data passed the quality check.

- Medical Contraindication
 - The number of residents from the total who cannot receive the COVID-19 vaccination due to a medical contraindication.
- Declined
 - The number of residents from the total who have declined the COVID-19 vaccination for a reason that is not a medical contraindication.
- Unknown Status
 - The number of residents from the total who have any of the following:
 - Unknown vaccination status
 - Only one dose of an unknown/unspecified manufacturer. This individual is categorized as unknown vaccination status because it is unclear if this single unspecified dose represents a partial or complete primary series.
 - A gap between their start date and the first status date that is entered, such as start date 1/1, declined on 2/3. The individual will be categorized as unknown vaccination status from 1/1 to 2/2
- Complete
 - The number of residents from the total who have completed the primary series of the COVID-19 vaccination.
- Up To Date
 - As of 12/26/2023 to 03/26/2023
 - The number of residents from the total in which any of the following is true:
 - Received an updated bivalent booster dose
 - Completed their primary series less than 2 months ago
 - As of 9/26/2022 to 12/25/2022
 - The number of residents from the total in which any of the following is true:
 - Received an updated bivalent booster dose
 - Received their last booster dose less than 2 months ago
 - Completed their primary series less than 2 months ago
